# Principal's Message

### Returning to School

It is very exciting that we are less than 1 month away from starting school again. It seems like forever since our students were in the building and learning with their teachers. In fact, it will be 165 days or five and a half months since the last official school day for our students in the building. After talking with our teachers, they are completely ready to start teaching here at school again. God calls some people to be teachers (Ephesians 4:11) and they are completely ready to go.

Our theme verse for this school year is, "For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control" (II Timothy 1:7). Lord willing we are planning to start school back in the school building on Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>. As II Timothy 1:7 discusses, we as Christians do not live in fear, but we do want to take precautions to keep our staff and students safe and our doors open. This year school may look differently than in the past, but at least for now it will be our new "normal". Some of the precautions that we will be doing at the start of the school year include: having hand sanitizers located strategically throughout the building, using disinfecting wipes on door handles, light switches, desks, and common areas throughout the day, maintaining physical distancing when possible, and daily screenings on everyone that enters the building. We know this plan is not perfect and may be subject to change, but we are striving to maintain safety for our staff, students, and the society at whole. Remember that God is a God of order (I Corinthians 14:33) and His ways our higher than our ways (Isaiah 55:8-9) and throughout this entire time away from school, hopefully we have all learned to trust God even more today than we did yesterday and especially back in March (Proverbs 3:5-6).

Finally, I know that some parents are completely ready for their students to start back to school later this month and some parents may still be a little hesitant and that is okay. I understand why some parents might feel a little hesitant, but I want you to know that we will strive to work together to keep your student(s) safe while at our school. I ask for all society to be praying for our students, staff, volunteers, and parents to help our students and staff stay safe and keeping our parents minds at rest. Isaiah 26:3 says, "You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You."




