New School Year

It is a very exciting time at the beginning of a new school year. Students are excited to see their friends, wear their new clothes, share memories that they made over the summer, and see the new classroom that their teacher decorated. Teachers are excited to see any new or returning students, sharing new and exciting lesson plans, and displaying their brandnew bulletin boards.

However, as the first day of school draws near, this can also cause some anxiety for teachers, students, and parents. As a student, this may be because they have a new teacher this year, they may have a new classroom, they may have new procedures, more homework, and just having to adjust to waking up early and going to bed on time may make for some anxious moments for the first day of school.

For teachers, they are anxiously hoping to have finished every item on the checklist prior to the first day of school, wondering if people are going to like their bulletin board, wondering how the new seating arrangement will work, hoping there is enough time to finish everything they had planned, and finally they hope all the students enjoy their first day of school.

For parents, it can be a little nervous as well. Parents are always a little nervous that their "baby" is going to enjoy the first day of school, are we going to be on time, what did we forget, where is the bus, did I pack a lunch for my student(s), what time are they getting home again, where are my car keys, and did we get all the supplies on the supply list.

As each of you know, the first day of school is very exciting but can cause some anxiety as well. Please remember to pray for every student, teacher, parent, and bus driver as they prepare for the first day of school that God would grant them peace during such an exciting but anxious time (John 16:33).

Parents, here are some items to remember as the first day of school approaches:

- 1. Remember that your student is taught every day from a reformed Biblical perspective. We teach them about God's death, burial, and resurrection (I Corinthians 15:3-4), how to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (II Peter 3:18), teaching them about creation and how God created the heavens and the earth in six literal days (Exodus 20:11), and then learning how to share about God's love to a lost and dying world (Acts 1:8).
- 2. Remember that every day your student(s) is loved, prayed for, prayed with, and personally discipled.

Finally, students that attend Peoria Christian school from grades pre/k-8th grade, receive a minimum of 9,821 hours of reformed Biblical Christian Education. That is equivalent to attending church regularly on Sunday morning and evening for 94 years. Thank you for your support of Christian Education and specifically Peoria Christian School!

7 TIPS FOR PARENTS FOR THE 1st DAY OF SCHOOL

- 1. Pray together as a family about going back to school.
- Start going to bed earlier (at least 1 week prior to school, have your student start getting into a routine of going to bed earlier). Start in 15 minute intervals.
- Start waking up earlier (again start at least 1 week prior and have your student start waking up 15 minutes earlier every day).
- Ask them questions about the first day of school (ex: are you wondering about anything about the first day of school, what do you think will be the hardest part of school, what are you looking forward to).
- Lay items out ahead of time (ex: clothes for the first day of school, backpack, and school supplies).
- 6. Remember you are not alone. Touch base with other parents to see ideas they might have.
- 7. It's okay if you forget something. Only God is perfect.
