The Board sang from Psalter Hymnal #557, My Jesus I Love Thee. Adam Fynaardt read from Ephesians 1:3-10 & opened with prayer. Minutes of the May meeting were read and approved.

From the Education Committee:

- Facilitators and Substitute Teacher lists were approved.
- ISAP testing and Map testing results were presented and discussed.
- IXL growth concluded with 108 points of growth in Math and 135 points of growth in Language Arts.
- Currently we have 47 students registered for the 24/25 school year.
- Mr. Cope reported that the Vermeer Workshop will be held on June 5 & 6.
- The 7th & 8th grade trip to the Ark Encounter and Creation Museum, on March 26-28, 2025, was approved.

- Have submitted goals and are awaiting final approval for reaccreditation.
